# *Paul's Conversion through Execution*

A.D. 33

Paul blinded  
Meets Jesus  
on road to

Plot to kill Paul  
but he escapes

Note; The timeline from conversion up until the first Missionary Journey is general in nature. Paul spent 3 years in Arabia, about 2 years in Tarsus with Barnabas and an undisclosed amount of time in Jerusalem after delivering support there, and some scholars believe his conversion was closer to A.D. 37.




